



STREET REPAIR AND RE-PAVING SERVICES REQUEST FOR BIDS

A. The Village is requesting sealed bids for re-paving the following streets

- 1) Brooks Street, West from 36 Brooks Street to Railroad Avenue, Approximately 1000 Ft.
- 2) Railroad Avenue, from Liberty Street to Brooks Street, Approximately 1000 Ft.
- 3) Railroad Avenue, from Academy St to Liberty St, Approximately 1200 Ft
- 4) Tompkins Street, West from 30 Tompkins Street to Tioga Street, Approximately 1000 Ft.

B. Repair potholes and seam cracks

- 1) Liberty Street
- 2) Kennedy Street
- 3) Ferris Street
- 4) Guile's Street
- 5) Railroad Street, Between Academy Street and Liberty Street
- 6) Nichols Street, At the entrance to the village parking lot
- 7) Academy Street, At the entrance to the village parking lot

C. Repair the road edge

- 1) Railroad Street, Both sides of the road from the railroad towards Sealytown Creek, Approximately 200 Ft

D. Repair the corner at road intersections

- 1) Southeast corner at Park Street and Academy Street
- 2) Both sides of the intersection of Guile's Street and Tioga Street
- 3) Northeast corner of the intersection of Railroad Avenue and Academy Street

E. Paint RR Crossing on the pavement both sides of the railroad at the railroad crossing on Academy St, Liberty Street and Brooks Street.



The work must meet or exceed the following requirements:

1. Provide traffic control.
2. Potholes larger than 1 Sq Ft to be milled, swept, tack coated before repaving
3. Potholes smaller than 1 Sq Ft to be swept and tack coated before repaving
4. Clean & prep – power broom the entire street.
5. Mill transition joints at intersections and where a street continues
6. Raise any gas valves.
7. Raise any drainage basins or mill transitions to them as appropriate.
8. Apply tack coat for bond, 0.1 to 0.15 gallons per square yard.
9. Apply 2” compacted thickness of Type 6 asphalt.
10. Provide transition at all driveways as necessary.
11. Provide 20 ft pull off area centered in front each existing mail box on the roads listed for repaving in section A.

Bid proposals must break out project costs separately for A1, A2, A3, A4, B1, B2, B3, B4, B5, B6, B7, C1, D1, D2, D3 and E.. However, the intent is for the work to be awarded to a single bidder. Bid proposals must specify proposed completion date earlier than July 1, 2024. The successful bidder must provide current certificate of insurance and Workman's Compensation and abide by the New York State Prevailing Wage Schedule for Public Works Projects.

Sealed bids will be opened on Tuesday, April 2, 2024 at the 5:15PM in the Village Municipal Building.
